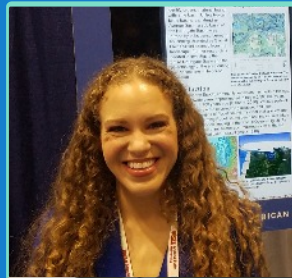
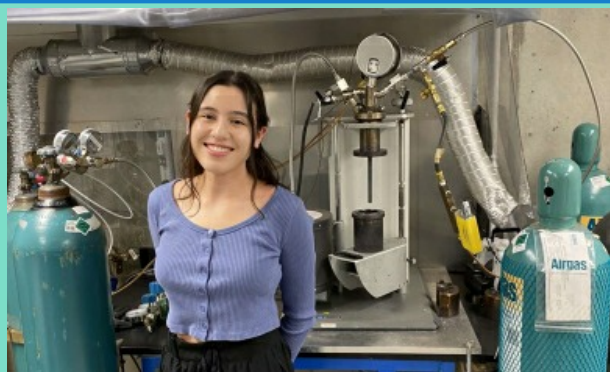

Who is Eligible?

- Female-identifying undergraduates committed to completing a Bachelor's Degree and pursuing a career or graduate work in the **Geosciences**
- Sophomore, junior, or senior women enrolled in a university or 2-year college in the states of **Washington** or **Oregon**.
- Minimum of 3.2 GPA (or equivalent academic achievement).

Application Components:

- Name, mailing address, phone number and email
- One paragraph each describing your (1) financial needs, (2) current financial resources, and (3) academic achievements.
- One-page essay summarizing your commitment to a career in the geosciences.
- All college transcripts (photocopies and scanned copies accepted).
- 3 letters of reference (via mail or email); including their names, affiliations, and contact phone numbers, sent to us directly. Writers must be:
 - 2 people familiar with your academic achievement and personal commitment, at least one of whom is a geoscience faculty member,
 - 1 person familiar with your financial needs. This person may be a relative or friend.

You may submit additional letters of reference.

Applicants will be judged on their potential for professional success, academic achievements, and financial need.

The recipient will be notified by late-February 2023
